Located on Long Pond in Manuels, CBS, just minutes from St. John's, The RNYC Sailing School runs a Sail Canada CANSail Junior Sailing Program, and Adult Learn-to-Sail Program, training sessions and regattas and is accepting applications for the position of Sailing School Head Coach for the 2020 season. Reporting directly to the Manager of the RNYC Sailing School, you will be responsible for the overall operation of the sailing school, staff and program participants.

Responsibilities include:

- Supervising all school staff
- Scheduling staff while following budgetary guidelines for allotted hours
- Overseeing all instruction to ensure highest quality offered and provide guidance to improve training and teaching skills
- Ensuring all instructors are following CANSail curriculum and reporting participant progression weekly
- Ensuring the delivery of a fun and quality sailing and learning experience for all participants
- Keeping safety of students as the top priority at all time
- Instructing CANSail lessons, as required
- Planning, organizing and operating of evening and weekend training sessions, private lessons and regattas
- Coaching training sessions some evenings and weekends
- Ensuring all equipment is kept in a good and safe condition by conducting ongoing inspections and taking preventative actions as well as maintenance as required.
