



Important RNYC Safety Notice

Hello Boating Members,

During the recent storm it was noted that several boats , on both wharves , had the lines attached to power poles adjacent to berths.

This is a risky practice and must not take place.

Should a power pole ever let go or snap off (as they have done in recent past) the results could be serious indeed. From loss of power to electrical overhead lines making contact with boats and or people.

At your earliest convenience please remove all lines from power poles.

An alternative and acceptable practice is to drop the lines through the Decking and around the Stringer and back through the Fender (or facing) board.

Please take time to remove all lines from power poles and attach them by an alternative method.
